

## Scam Alert

Techtronic Industries Co. Ltd. (TTI) has been made aware that **scam emails purporting to be from or associated with TTI have been circulated**, using **unauthorized and misleading email domains** that are not owned, operated or approved by TTI, such as ***ttigroup.li***.

These fraudulent communications may **appear to originate from TTI's directors or employees**, and may **request payments, the supply of goods, services or other benefits, personal information, or other actions**. TTI confirms that such communications are not legitimate and do not originate from TTI.

### *How to Identify Legitimate TTI Communications*

- Emails containing **unexpected or unusual requests should be treated as suspicious**.
- TTI does **not request confidential information, banking details, passwords, or urgent payments** via unsolicited emails.

### *Recommended Actions*

- **DO NOT respond to, forward, or act upon** any suspicious emails.
- **DO NOT click on links or open attachments** contained in such communications.
- If you are uncertain about the authenticity of a communication claiming to be from TTI, please **verify it using the contact details published on TTI's official website (<https://www.ttigroup.com/contacts/tti-offices>)**.

We take this matter seriously and are taking appropriate steps to address this matter. In addition to public alerts, we also provide training on cybersecurity and data protection for our employees. TTI has taken every effort to protect our data and online security. We appreciate your vigilance and cooperation in helping to prevent fraud.
